## OBSERVATIONS:

- All the faculty(100%) agreed that the curriculum and syllabus are need based
- Around 47% of the faculty strongly agreed and 52% agreed that course outcomes are well defined and clear
- Around 52% of the faculty strongly agreed, 42% agreed and one faculty is neutral on the number of relevant reading materials and digital resources available in the library
- The course has good balance between theory and application is strongly agreed by 47% and agreed by 36% faculty
- Around 52% strongly agreed and 47% agreed that the syllabus of the course increased their knowledge and perspective in the subject area
- Around 36% of the faculty strongly agreed, 26% of them agreed and 36% of them are neutral that they have the freedom to propose, modify, suggest and incorporate new topics in the syllabus through proper forum. As most of the faculty are members of the university board of studies, they have the freedom to propose new topics in the syllabus. But the remaining faculty are not members and hence they maintained neutrality

- 57% of the faculty strongly agreed, 36% agreed and one faculty maintained neutrality that they have the freedom to adopt new techniques in teaching.
- With respect to achieving minimum required course outcome attainment level 57% strongly agreed and 42% agreed.
- Almost 78% strongly agreed and 21% agreed that they have taken sufficient steps to provide assistance to slow learners. All the faculty provide assistance to slow learners by conducting revision classes, study hours and remedial coaching.
- Faculty who are the members of the university board of studies (around 47%) strongly agreed that they have contributed to the curriculum and syllabus development, and 26% faculty agreed and 15% remained neutral and one faculty disagreed and one more faculty strongly disagreed.
