The above data shows the feedback of the students with reference to delivery of course curriculum and other facilities. The career –oriented syllabus was quite helpful for them to find out an employment soon after student’s graduation. The college has a positive and balanced academic atmosphere.

Observations:

An online survey conducted to know the extent of Student satisfaction on Institutional performance for the year 2019-20 reveals that overall rating for satisfaction with educational experience in the college is at an average of 4.2 on a 5 point scale. Quality of teaching faculty, career counseling and placement, courses offered, teaching learning process, library and campus have been rated between 4.2-4.3 with library and classroom and lab facilities close behind. These results have been reported.

Observations:

1. Curriculum and syllabai of the courses

The above table depicts that the college curriculum is excellent for about 90% of the respondents. And around 9% of the respondents rated it as very good. The career –oriented syllabus was quite helpful for them to find out an employment soon after their graduation. The college has a positive and balanced academic atmosphere and the students are satisfied with the accessibility of reference books.

2. Extent of syllabus covered in the class

67% of the respondents rated excellent about the syllabus covered in the class and almost 30% rated it as very good. The institute mostly focused on the syllabus completion and Also conducts sufficient number of revision classes for the slow learners.

3. Course delivery by faculty members in the class

In addition to the syllabus completion, the effectiveness of the methodology and delivery by the faculty in the class room plays a vital role in the understanding of the student. This institute gives utmost importance to the process of course delivery. The above table is a reflection of the course delivery by faculty in the class. Here 93% of the respondents rated it as 93%.

4. Usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty to facilitate teaching

48% of the respondents rated it as excellent and 40% of them rated it as very good. And one respondent believed that it is fair. In addition to this most of the faculty in this institute opines that usage of ICT and blended teaching are highly essential after Covid pandemic.

5. Fairness in the assessment processes

Around 58% rated it as excellent and around 35% opines that the assessment process is very good. This institute follows continuous internal assessment by conducting student seminars, group discussion, quiz, project work, and two internal tests in a semester

6. Timely announcement of exam results

The above table depicts that around 63% of the respondents rated it as excellent and around 26% of them rated it as very good. Despite this most of the faculty strongly believes that the announcement of results was delayed due to problems associated with post covid situations.

7. Opportunities in the institute for research activities

As this institute is only for under graduate students, we have limited opportunities for research activities. Most of the respondents rated it as good and one respondent rated it as poor. Despite our limitations, we strive to inculcate research related activities through project work. And we would like to introduce compulsory internship program for all the students.

8. Opportunity for students to participate in internship, student exchange, field visit

Around 32% of the students rated it as excellent and 48% of them rated it as very good. We currently include student field visits in our curriculum. But we would like to introduce compulsory internship program for all the students.

9. Opportunity for out of class room learning

69% of the respondents rated it as excellent and 26% of them rated it as 26%. And most of the faculty strongly believes that out of the class room learning should be enhanced in the curriculum.

10. Overall learning experience

Around 62% of the respondents rated it as excellent and around 31% of them rated it as very good and 7% of them responded it as good. This institute strongly believes in enhancing the overall experience of the students during their course period by bringing innovative changes in the teaching learning process.
