The college Profile:

Government Degree College, Naidupet, was established in 1983 as a women's college and later converted into a co-educational institution. It is located on the southern periphery of the Nellore District, adjoining the Chittoor District. In the beginning, the college was situated in a private building. Then it was moved to the Panchayat Samiti office, which was donated by one of the Constitutional Drafting Committee members, Sri Alladi Krishna Swamy Iyengar. After the land and buildings were transferred to the college administration on July 6, 2010.

The college started with the conventional courses, B.A. and B.Com. Later, BSc was also introduced in 1995, along with a restructured course in BSC (Microbiology, Botany, and Chemistry). The college was recognized by UGC under Sections 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act 1956 in May 2011 and became eligible to receive UGC grants. It received the latest UGC financial assistance in 2015.

The college was accredited by the NAAC in 2016 (2nd cycle) with a "B" grade. It continues its journey of academic excellence in imparting quality higher education by responding to academic and administrative challenges. This

assessment would enhance our institution's quality and raise the college's academic profile.

The college is affiliated with Vikrama Simhapuri University, Nellore, and presently offers five UG courses in the disciplines of arts, science, and commerce, both conventional and restructured. The college has a 6.04-acre green campus consisting of four blocks.

The college caters to the needs of backward students with rural backgrounds. Our motto is to serve the rural community by providing them with quality education. The majority of our students come from disadvantaged communities. Through the medium of higher education, we aim to uplift them in all spheres of their lives.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COLLEGE

- 1. At the time of admission the student must register his/ her residential address in the college office. If there is any change in the address it must be intimated to the office.
- 2. The students put the grievances/complaints in the complaint box which is placed at the Department of English.
- **3.** Students should apply for leave sanction beforehand. Continuous absence without notice will be viewed seriously.
- 4. They must not spit on the walls, floor, pillars or doors of the college, scribbling, pasting placards or poster or otherwise disfiguring college wall or black boards are strictly prohibited. Such students when identified shall be punished to the extent of removal from rolls.
- 5. Students are forbidden to loiter in the corridors. When they have no classes to attend, can use the library during leisure hours.
- **6.** Students are warned against tampering the light and fan switches and water taps and fittings.
- 7. Students should take their seats before the teacher enters the class room and should not ordinarily leave their seats during the lecture hour.
- 8. Students should have their identity cards with

- them during college hours, college functions and must produce them for verification on demand.
- **9.** Every student should wear the college uniform from Monday to Thursday.
- 10. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college.
- 11. No student should leave the class room without the permission of the lecturers. Also the student should not leave the class before the lecturer departure.
- **12**. Do not transact any work in the college office during class hours.
- **13.** Do not loiter any whether on the college campus during the class hours
- **14** .Students are advised to check the notice board every day for information and instructions
- 15. Students are expected to be punctual to the theory and practical classes and leave the college premises after the college hours.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria for Jagananna Vidya Deevena Scheme

- 1. Only the students who are residents of Andhra Pradesh state are eligible to get the benefits of the scheme.
- 2. Students must have completed Class 12 and avail of admission in the colleges/ universities or institutes for further education in regular courses.
- 3. Only the students whose family income is not more than Rs 2.50 lacs are entitled to apply.
- 4. The benefits of the **Jagananna Vidya Deevena Scheme** are available for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, backward classes, minorities, Kapus, economically backward classes, and differently-abled categories of students.
- 5. Those with 10 acres of wetland and 25 acres of dry land are also eligible for the benefit.
- 6. If the applying candidate or any family member is a government employee or pensioner then he/she is not eligible. No family member of students is paying Income Tax.
- 7. The students who are from families of sanitation workers and the students who are professionally dependent on taxis, autos, and tractors are also eligible to avail of the benefits of the scheme.
