- **Interactive Q&A:** A lively Question and Answer session followed, where students and staff actively sought clarifications and guidance on personal health concerns related to menstrual cycles, diet, and stress.

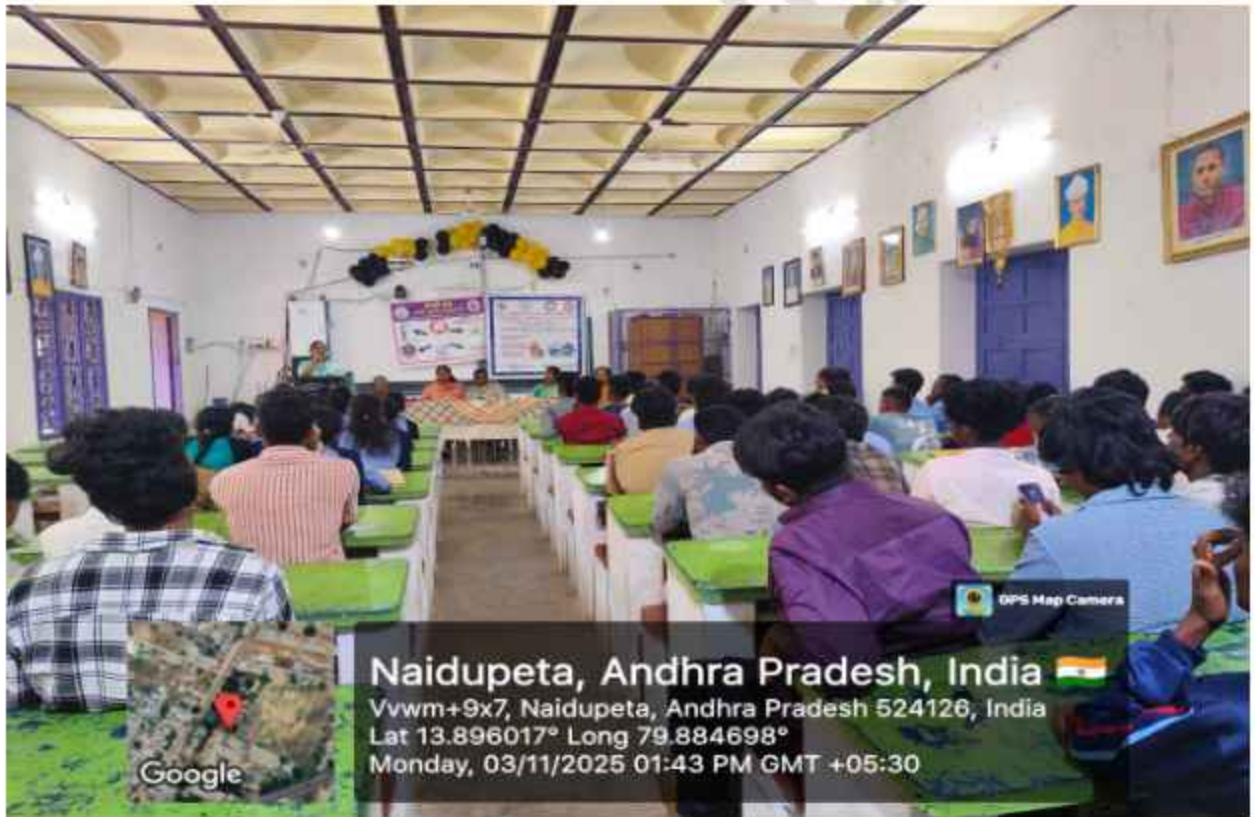
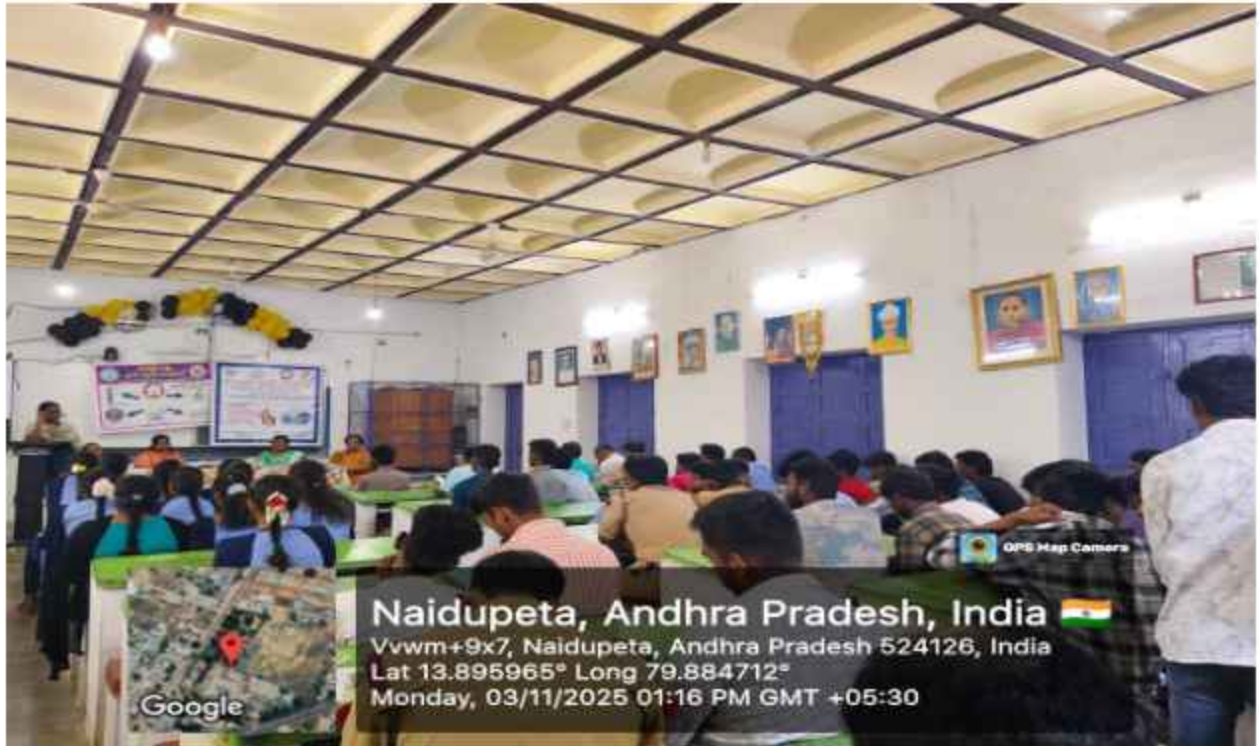
A Step Towards Health Literacy
