- ❖ Institutional Development Plan (Next two years)

The Institutional Development Plan (IDP) for Government Degree College (GDC), Naidupet, is designed for the academic cycle of 2026-27 and 2027-28. ## 1. Institutional Vision & Mission

- **Vision:** To evolve into a "Centre of Excellence" that empowers rural and underprivileged students through 21st-century skills, ethical values, and global competitiveness.
- **Mission:** \* To provide high-quality, job-oriented education to the socially and economically marginalized sections of Naidupet and surrounding areas.
  - To foster a research-oriented culture among faculty and students.
  - To integrate the **Indian Knowledge System (IKS)** with modern scientific temperament.

To meet the requirements of a modern learning environment, the campus infrastructure must be upgraded.

- Digital Classrooms: Convert 50% of existing classrooms into "Hybrid Learning Studios" equipped with high-speed internet and interactive panels.
- Girls' Hostel: Following the 2026 Budget proposal for a girls' hostel in every district, the college will prioritize the completion and modernization of on-campus housing to improve female enrollment (currently ~30%).
- Laboratory Upgradation: \* Phase 1 (2026): Modernize Physics and Chemistry labs with digital sensors.
  - Phase 2 (2027): Establish a centralized "Innovation & Startup Incubator" for student entrepreneurs.

### 4. Research, Innovation & Faculty Development

- Faculty Training: 100% of faculty to complete AI Teacher Training Certification to use AI tools (ChatGPT, Gemini, etc.) for lesson planning and assessment.
- Research Grants: Encourage the 12+ Ph.D. holders on staff to apply for Major/Minor Research Projects from UGC or AP State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE).
- Publications: Aim for at least one publication per department in Scopus/UGC-CARE listed journals annually.

### 5. Student Support & Holistic Development

- Placement Cell: Strengthen the Jawahar Knowledge Centre (JKC) to provide intensive training in Soft Skills and Coding, targeting a 20% increase in campus placements.
- Inclusivity: Operationalize the Inclusive Centre to support Divyangjan (students with disabilities) with assistive technologies as per the *Divyangjan Kaushal Yojana*.
- Extra curriculars: Expand NSS and Red Ribbon Club activities to include "Climate Literacy" campaigns.
  - Revive the Eco-Club with a "Green Campus" initiative (Solar panels and Rainwater harvesting).

- NAAC Re-accreditation: Target an 'A' Grade in the upcoming NAAC cycle by streamlining documentation via a digital Management Information System (MIS).
- Academic Audit: Conduct biannual internal academic audits and one external audit by the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education (CCE).
- Alumni Engagement: Formalize the Alumni Association to create an "Alumni Fund" for scholarships and infrastructure maintenance.

- CSR Funding: Approach industries in the Naidupet industrial cluster for funding specific laboratory equipment or green initiatives.
